MOJI (WRITING) COURSE

The **Moji (Writing) Course** is for beginners who are interested in learning how to read & write Japanese Characters (Hiragana, Katakana and basic Kanji).

The learners will take up words, sentences and some basic Kanji characters, which have appeared in the MARUGOTO A1 textbook. As such, it is preferred that the applicants have completed the Marugoto A1 course or possess an equivalent background* (approximately 50 hours of Nihongo classes or self-studying).
