## Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT)

### Interactive Lecture and Exercises

The Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT), which was modified in 2010, measures communicative competence required to perform tasks. Not only a learner's knowledge of vocabulary and grammar, but also his/her Japanese comprehension at using the knowledge in practical communication will be tested.

This lecture is for those who have not yet taken the JLPT, or for those who have taken a certain level, but would like to know the contents of a different level that they plan to take. Participants will be introduced to the types of questions which will appear in each test section to familiarize them with the nature of the JLPT. This is open to those who plan to take level N5, N4, or N3.

N1 and N2 measure the level of understanding of Japanese used in a broad range of scenes in actual everyday life.  
N3 is a bridging level between N1/N2 and N4/N5.
