




Marugoto Starter A1 Module 2

At the end of the course, learners will be able to:

1. Understand and use familiar everyday expressions and very basic phrases aimed at the satisfaction of needs of a concrete type, such as how to get to a destination, how to do shopping.
2. Ask and answer questions about personal details such as one's hobby and schedule.
3. Express one's feelings and preferences.
4. Interact in a simple way provided the other person talks slowly and clearly, and is prepared to help.
