### **Bid for Accident and Health Insurance Coverage of Plan**

- 1) **Period of Insurance:** **March 1, 2021 – August 31, 2021**
  - 2) **Type of Insurance:** Accident and Health
  - 3) **Coverage:**
    - Medical – PHP 50,000 / person
    - Accidental (Death) – PHP 100,000 / person
  - 4) **Number of Insured Persons:** **Around 300\***
  - 5) **Requisite Benefit:**
    - No-cash-out at the accredited hospitals
    - **Affiliated DOH clinics in all provinces of the Philippines.**
    - **Reimbursement on non-accredited clinics**
    - The accredited hospitals must include the following hospitals:

- \*Insured persons are the candidates who take the Japanese-language training at **PAD**, and the other facilities before they are dispatched to Japan to work as nurses and caregivers under the Japan-Philippines Economic Partnership Agreement (JPEPA).
