KATSUDOO (ACTIVITY)

practice communicative language activities used within the context of Japanese settings & learn how to speak simple Japanese right away

RIKAI (COMPETENCE)

learn the Japanese Language structure (Japanese script, vocabulary, grammar) through various communicative activities

- 01** Understand and use familiar everyday expressions and very basic phrases aimed at the satisfaction of needs of a concrete type, such as how to order food and drinks.

- 03** Interact in a simple way provided the other person talks slowly and clearly, and is prepared to help.
- 04** Broaden one's view, understand the culture of other countries, and develop the competence in intercultural understanding by taking up Japanese culture distinct from that of the Philippines.
