KATSUDOO (ACTIVITY)

practice communicative language activities used within the context of Japanese settings & learn how to speak simple Japanese right away

RIKAI (COMPETENCE)

learn the Japanese Language structure (Japanese script, vocabulary, grammar) through various communicative activities

AT THE END OF THE COURSE, STUDENTS WILL BE ABLE TO:

- 01** Understand and use familiar everyday expressions and very basic phrases aimed at the satisfaction of needs of a concrete type, such as how to get to a destination, how to do some shopping.
- 02** Ask and answer questions about personal details such as one's hobby and schedule.
- 03** Express one's feelings and preferences.
- 04** Interact in a simple way provided the other person talks slowly and clearly and is prepared to help.
- 05** Broaden one's view, understand the culture of other countries, and develop the competence in intercultural understanding by taking up Japanese culture distinct from that of the Philippines.
